Career Summary

Dougie joined Interserve in September 2006 as Managing Director of Interserve Investments Plc. Interserve Investments directs all of the Group's Private Finance Initiative activities; it leads the bid process and manages the company's PFI equity investments, playing a key role in securing long-term revenue for other parts of the Group.

Before joining Interserve from 3i, where he was a partner in its infrastructure team, Dougie spent 10 years in infrastructure investment focusing on the Private Finance Initiative and working for both the public and private sectors.

Dougie began his career with seven years in the Royal Engineers. Between 1995 and 1999 he worked for HM Treasury leading deals on behalf of the government, including the redevelopment of the HM Treasury, GCHQ and National Savings buildings. From 1999 to 2004 he was Managing Director of Amey Ventures where he was responsible for a wide portfolio of bids and investments in the schools, MoD, rail and roads sectors. He then moved to Lend Lease where he was Managing Director of its PFI hospitals and schools business.
